The "Atti della Accademia Peloritana dei Pericolanti", founded in 1729, have been published since 1878. The Medico-Biological Section (II Classe) of the Accademia was established in 1944 and published its Proceedings up to 2010 in annual volumes.

Since 2017 the II Classe publishes a e-only Journal entitled APMB | Atti della Accademia Peloritana dei Pericolanti , starting from vol. 105.

APMB | Atti della Accademia Peloritana dei Pericolanti is an international journal, devoted to the dissemination of scientific results obtained by the Members of the Accademia, with an international editorial board, covering all fields of Bio-medical , Veterinary ,basic and clinical Life Sciences.

Clinical case Seminars presented at the scientific sessions of the Accademia are published after being submitted to rigorous peer review along with both clinical, translational and basic Original studies, as well as solicited Scholarly dialogs, according to the rules of the II Class.

Clinical case Seminars, Scholarly dialogs and Original studies may be submitted for publication also by Non-Members of the Accademia.

OJM - Open Journals Messina [1] is a service provided by the Library System of the University of Messina that uses OJS - Open Journal Systems, a journal management and publishing system that has been developed by the Public Knowledge Project through its federally funded efforts to expand and improve access to research [2].
